Practical meets elegant in this highly organised dressing and storage zone.

When Sydney couple Judi and Paul became empty nesters, they chose not to downsize. Instead, they took it as a cue to re-shape elements of their existing family home.

They enlisted interior architect Andrew Waller of Mr Waller design studio to help reconfigure their floor plan. Their mission was to make the interiors flow more comfortably, with a fresh contemporary look.

One area they wanted to improve was the walk-in robe attached to their bedroom. "Their existing robe storage areas needed better planning and much more storage capacity," says Andrew.

In the revised layout, he cleverly combined the walk-in robe and a hallway linen cupboard, converting them into an L-shaped dressing room that wraps around a new ensuite. The area contains his-and-hers clothing spaces (hanging, shelving and drawers), plenty of dresser storage for jewellery and accessories, and open storage for shoes and handbags. For convenience, there is also a three-panelled hinged door with full-length mirrors which "allows you to check out an outfit from just about any angle – a design that is borrowed from upmarket fashion change rooms", says Andrew.

In keeping with the colours used in other parts of the house, the dressing room is awash with soft neutrals and blue/grey accents.

The effect is stately, elegant and tranquil. This room radiates calm and order, flowing stylistically and tonally with the adjacent ensuite and the rest of the interiors.
